II. REGISTRATION AT BOTH UGA AND UniMi



Registration at UGA for both UGA and UniMi students has to be done prior to your arrival in Grenoble.

Students who do not already live in Grenoble should inform Guergana (<u>guergana.mitrouchev@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr</u>) about their exact date of arrival. Students are expected to be in Grenoble on **Monday**, the 3rd of September 2018 for the start of the university new academic year.

Registration on the internet runs from 06.07.2018 to 21.07.2018.

In late August, you will have to come to UGA in order to get your student

cards issued. The usual procedure for this would be to get an appointment through a web application. However, you don't need to do it, instead:

Please let Guergana know by e-mail the date and time you would like to come to her office (470 rue de la Chimie, bâtiment André Rassat, office E106) for registration, between the 28.08 and 31.08.2018. She works every morning from 9 am to 12.45 pm. On this appointment, you will have to bring along some documents (ID card, last diploma obtained etc.). You will be sent a list with the required documents.

Below is a summary of the key steps to follow:

- It is of high importance that you first create a CVEC account (<u>https://cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr/</u>) and pay a fee called "Contribution vie étudiante et de campus". Registration at UGA cannot be completed if this fee is not paid. You will then get a certificate. Please keep it, you will have to show it to Guergana when you will go to her office in late August.
- Follow the online registration procedure through one of the links above.
- In late August, go to Guergana's office for your student card to be issued.

B/ AT UGA FOR UniMi STUDENTS

A specific registration file is sent by email and has to be filled in and returned **before 27.08.2018**. Registration will be finalized upon arrival, in Guergana's office (that is why it is of high importance that you keep her informed about your arrival date in Grenoble). In this purpose, please make an appointment with her as soon as possible so that she can proceed to your registration from **28.08 to 31.08.2018 (student cards will be issued).** This could also be done later – however - as the academic year starts on 03.09.2018, without a student card by this date, you will have trouble to get some student services (such as the library or the refectory).

III. <u>HEALTH CARE</u>



Students coming from UniMi have to request a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) from the local Italian Health Institution, so that health care during their stay in France can be provided.

Likewise, UGA students have to request an EHIC from the *CPAM (Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie)* a few weeks/months before leaving for UniMi at S2. For more information: <u>https://www.ameli.fr/</u>

The EHIC can be requested online from your personal account.

IV. FRENCH PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

Please note that in France, you are required to sign up for **public liability insurance** (assurance responsabilité civile). That is basically an insurance contract that protects you any time in case of accident (caused to you or by you). Such insurance is usually included when subscribing to a house insurance contract - which is also compulsory to get upon arrival in Grenoble.

The deadline to apply for accommodation was 01.07.2018, but your applications will still be taken into consideration, provided that there are some free rooms left.

In France, in order to rent a room or an apartment, you need to show some financial guarantees to the landlord/ have someone for financial back up, called "cautionnaire" (a family member for example). If you do not have such a financial back up, please have a look at <u>https://www.visale.fr.</u> This is basically a french organisation that can help students with getting a backed-up when renting an accommodation.

VI. FRENCH LANGUAGE COURSES

You will get the opportunity to learn French while studying at UGA. **CUEF (Centre universitaire d'études françaises)** offers French courses for every level throughout the year.

If you are interested in taking French classes, please note that they are not included in the PLANT-Int teaching programme, i.e you will have to pay extra. A leaflet with the French courses prices is provided with this students'guide. Registration for French lessons has to be done directly at CUEF, anytime. It is located on the Campus :

A language proficiency test has to be taken upon registration. A short interview is also carried out. At the very end of the courses, you will be handed a certificate. Please be aware that no ECTS will be awarded for French lessons.

The two best price options are the following:

- a one-week intensive French course either from 27.08 to 31.08.2018 or from 03.09 to 07.09.2018 (5 days, 4h/day from 12.30 pm): 160 euros (20% discount for UGA students included).

- French classes throughout S1, from 01.10 to 14.12.2018 (10 weeks, 2h/week). Lessons are held in the evening from 6.30 to 8.30 pm (days on which lessons are held can be chosen. Please get in touch with CUEF): 360 euros (20% discount for UGA students included).

Another nice way to learn French for free is to find a "tandem partner" with **IntEGre** (<u>https://www.integre-grenoble.org/</u>) – a student association.

VII. ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

Italian language courses are offered by a specific UGA Faculty called *Maison des Langues.*

Here is its website: <u>https://sdl.univ-grenoble-alpes.fr/accueil-182978.kjsp</u> Again, these courses are not included in the PLANT-Int teaching programme and no ECTS will be granted. Interested students have to get in touch with *Maison des Langues* and pay extra to attend Italian lessons.



VIII. FINANCIAL AIDS

A/ FOR UGA STUDENTS GOING TO UniMi AT S2

PLANT-Int is being subsidized by the **Région Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes** that should provide outgoing students (whose home Institution is UGA) with a **financial aid** (approx. 1000 euros) during their stay in Milan.

About 70% of the PLANT-Int scholarship will be paid upon arrival in Milan (late January 2019).

For this, students will have to fill in and sign the form "Décision individuelle d'attribution _étudiant sortant_Aides à la mobilité SCUSI" prior to their stay in Milan.

Upon arrival in Milan, students have to get signed a certificate by a UniMi representative, proving that the student is safely arrived.

During the stay in Milan, it is of high importance that you promote the scholarship, as it is granted by the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes Region (www.auvergnerhonealpes.fr/). As an example, at the very end of an oral presentation, you can mention on a slide that your stay in Milan has been made possible both by this grant ant the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes Region. You will then have to provide us with your powerpoint presentation, so that we can send it to the "Conseil Régional" as a proof. This procedure is a term in the contract that grants UGA the PLANT-Int subsidy. A powerpoint presentation is given as an example. We will accept any other form of publicity as long as you can prove that you actually promoted the Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes Region.

At the very end of your stay in Milan, the pending amount of the scholarship (about 30%) will be paid upon receipt of both another certificate and a report about your stay ("Rapport de fin de mobilité").



In addition to the Région Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes fellowship, there are possibilities to apply to other Master fellowships: **Erasmus +** (procedure pending for students whose home Institution is UGA), or **Idex** (for students who got their latest degree in a foreign university).
